How to Begin Research

Compile a list of subject key words

Synonyms

Check the spelling

Start Small

Find between 5-10 resources that
match your subject. Analyze these
sources for your paper before gathering
additional information.

Create a rough outline. Based on
the information you have already
collected write down a summary of
what you want to cover in your paper.

Where to Look for information

Books - in depth overviews or historic
background on a subject

Database - For scholarly research
articles that give specific case data or
recent developments in an area

Internet - for demographic statistics
or current information that has not yet
been published academically
